<b>Pre-residency Teacher Meeting:</b> Facilitate coordination with Teaching Artist and all involved Teachers	At least 1 week before residency	JAHC Education Director, AIS Liaison and Teaching Artist
Publicize residency and final events in classroom/school newsletters.	Before/during residency	Principal and Classroom Teachers
Document student learning and teaching artist/teachers/students doing art.	During residency	Principal, Classroom Teachers and JAHC Education Director
